



Notice to Napa Sanitation District Customers

On July 1, 2010, the sewer service charge for one Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU) will increase by 1.8% to reflect the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) during the previous 12 month period. For a single family dwelling, this will result in an increase of \$8 annually.

June 2010

**Current sewer service charge:
\$421 per year per EDU**

**New 2010-11 sewer service charge:
\$429 per year per EDU**

An Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU) is the combination of flow and strength of waste generated by a single family home. All sewer service charges are based on the number of EDUs used by a particular connection. The sewer service charge for an EDU increases or decreases annually based on the CPI, and this charge appears on your property tax bill.
