

POOL/SPA WATER DISCHARGE PERMIT

This facility is hereby authorized to discharge pool/spa water into the Napa Sanitation District sewer system in accordance with the conditions set forth in this permit. Noncompliance with any term or condition of this permit shall constitute a violation of the Napa Sanitation District Sewer Use Ordinance. This is a temporary permit designed to accommodate repairs or removal of pools and spas.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS & PROHIBITIONS

- Napa Sanitation District may collect a sample of pool/spa water to confirm compliance with the District's local limit for Copper at 0.21 mg/L prior to allowing discharge to the sanitary sewer if copper has been used for algae control. The laboratory turnaround time for copper analysis is 7 to 10 working days.
- This facility must comply with the accompanying Pollution Prevention Tips as stated on the Best Management Practices brochure.
- Discharge shall be kept at a flow rate that will not cause a surcharge to the sewer line, manhole, or other users. In order to prevent backflow, do not seal the connection between hose and sewer line.
- Diatomaceous earth, leaves, mud, and other large solids etc. may not be discharged into the sanitary sewer.
